Interaction Patterns of Teachers and Students in Online Learning Subjects Al-**Quran Hadith**

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to determine the interaction patterns of teachers and students in online learning of al-quran hadist subjects MA Assulaimaniyah Mojolegi Mojoagung. Qualitative Research method with theoretical analysis approach using interview, observation and documentation techniques, the result of this research is to know the interaction pattern teachers and student in online learning and knowing the inhibiting factors and supporting factors for online learning while the inhibiting factor is the constraint of communication tools, games and helping parents. And the supporting factors for online learning are data packages from the government, teacher motivation.

INTRODUCTION

In every educational process, there must be interaction between teachers and students, in carrying out teaching tasks. This interaction process is carried out to convey messages (teaching materials). Interaction will be closely related to the existence of communication, in the communication process known as communicants and communicators (Lilawati & Cahyani, 2022). An interaction can occur when there are two parties who are both active in conveying their messages (Masruhani, Siti Nur. 2016). In addition, interaction can occur when there is a reciprocal relationship between two or more people (Djamarah, Syaiful Bahri. 2010).

Chandrawati (2010) states that, e-learning (electronic learning) is a distance learning process by combining principles in the learning process with technology. Mieke and Nyoman (2019:136) Efforts in implementing learning actions for students are followed by activities of selecting, determining, developing a learning model to achieve the desired learning outcomes. The activities of selecting, determining, and developing the model are based on the available learning conditions. In line with (Rusman, Kurniawan & Riyana. 2012) which states that web-based learning is a learning activity that utilizes media sites (websites) that can be accessed via the internet (Waqfin, 2022). Web-based learning or also known as "web-based learning" is one type of application of electronic learning (e-learning). In practice, students and teachers no longer need to carry out face-to-face teaching and learning activities in the classroom, but now they can learn with an online learning system. The teacher gives daily assignments as a means of obtaining student grades which will be included in the report card. The assessment is a reference for achieving learning objectives in accordance with what is expected in the midst of the Covid-19 virus outbreak (Rahmawati et al., 2021).

METHOD

The approach used in this study is a qualitative approach, which is a research procedure that produces descriptive data in the form of speech or writing and observable behavior from the person (subject) itself. With this qualitative research approach, the researcher will make a description of the description of the object being studied systematically, whether it is about the facts, characteristics and various things related to the research theme (Arif Furchan. 1992).

Through interviews with Mrs. Laili Indra Mufidah, S.Ag (Teacher of Al-Quran Hadith class XII) and several students of class XII MA Assulaimaniyah Mojolegi Mojoagung.

Through the whatsapp group, the teacher conveys material, which can also be in the form of voice notes, starting from the opening, delivering material, sharing material in the form of photos and others, which have been sought from various sources, to closing, and to motivate students to be enthusiastic in the learning process. For the interaction pattern of teachers and students the response was very good during the learning process, the teacher also monitored the children's development related to online learning. By learning to use WhatsApp groups, it is easier for teachers to deliver material, and students do not find it difficult during the online learning process by using WhatsApp media strategies. The teacher creates a relaxed, fun learning atmosphere, the most important thing is that the learning objectives are achieved and fulfilled
