This virus greatly affects the nature of life from various aspects.

Corona Virus Desese 2019 in each country has a different path (Anggraeni, 2020).Each country provides its own policy to reduce the number of the spread of this virus. The policies that have been intensified by the Indonesian government to reduce the spread of this virus include implementing large-scale social distancing in all regions of Indonesia from regional to central areas. This is nothing but so that this dangerous virus does not undermine it from various aspects, especially in aspects of education in Indonesia. Wabah This epidemic has forced Educational activities from all elements to only be carried out through distance education. Distance education itself has never been carried out in a compact manner before (Sadikin & Hamidah, 2020).Considering that during a pandemic, time, location, and distance are big problems (Herliandry et al., 2020) so one solution to this problem is distance education. The pandemic period is a challenge for all elements of education for the realization of active education even though school buildings are passive.

The passivity of school buildings really brings changes in science and technology for all elements of education. All learning activities that were originally face-to-face must be carried out virtually through various applications available for the realization of learning for students (Nasrulloh et al, 2020). Through Edmodo media, you can share documents and learning links, so that you can help teachers create online classes based on class divisions in schools that are added with online learning material and online evaluation features, where there are quizzes, assignments, and scoring for each lesson. Features on the Edmodo learning media are often described as Facebook for schools and function more according to needs (Akib & Uluelang, 2019). Edmodo is comprehensive, accessing Edmodo is faster and easier to apply by utilizing various features that function the same as the course management system.

The teacher is used as the main facilitator in the implementation of learning. Where teachers are required to prioritize creativity to create a classroom atmosphere that does not seem monotonous (Roziqin & Istiqomah, 2021). In the learning process in pandemic classes, it is still rare to find the use of Edmodobased e-learning. Especially in learning Islamic Religious Education at SDN PAMOTAN. The online learning process that is carried out still seems boring, makes students not interested and rarely responds to the learning material provided (Sirojudin & Yulianto, 2021). In fact, Edmodo-mediated learning is very good and more memorable for students because it is able to direct new knowledge and the creativity of the students themselves. Edmodo learning media, apart from being able to be used by students and teachers, can also be used by parents who want to monitor children's learning progress by using account registration as student guardians. The student's guardian asks for approval from the teacher to join a group where his child is registered in the group. 


Figure 1. E-learning Learning Process with Edmodo Media


METHOD



In learning Islamic Religious Education, the teacher mentions the class and title of the material and then conveys it to the students so that students can provide comments or responses to the material presented by the teacher. like in the picture below



From the presentation above, it can be illustrated that the group that has been created functions as a place for delivering teaching materials, adding group members consisting of students who are members of the class. In the process of learning Islamic Religious Education, the teacher provides material as well as quizzes to the group that has been made, then the students can respond to the material provided by the teacher by mentioning the name and class of each student in the comments column. This also applies when students will answer the quiz given by the teacher, only the students must answer the quiz in the replay column.



From the picture above, it can be concluded that the students answered the quiz questions given by the teacher through the replay column. Edmodo in its application to learning Islamic religious education is used as a complement, where teachers use the Edmodo application more to provide varied material and also quizzes to students. The interaction of teachers and students in learning using Edmodo is believed to have succeeded in making learning Islamic religious education more interesting. and interactive for students.

Learning Islamic religious education with Edmodo media has several benefits that will be obtained by various elements of education that use the media, including increasing interaction between teachers and students, forming an online class with various variations of learning, changing the traditional learning system into interactive learning.
