METHOD

The brainstorming method is a teaching technique carried out by teachers in the classroom, namely by presenting a problem to the class by the teacher, then students answer or express opinions, or comments so that perhaps the problem develops into a new problem, or can also be interpreted as one way to get a lot of ideas from a group of people in a short time.

Implementation of Brainstorming learning

The implementation of Brainstorming according to Fruner and Robinson (Rochaminah, 2008) states that to improve critical mathematical thinking skills, learning must be focused on understanding concepts with various approaches rather than procedural skills. Meanwhile, according to (Rochaminah, 2008) to achieve conceptual understanding, recognizing problems can help create a thinking atmosphere for students.

Discussion

- No criticism

Assessment is deferred until the idea evaluation stage. If there is no assessment and criticism at the stage of conveying ideas, obstacles in conveying ideas can be overcome so that the creative potential of individuals or groups can develop.

- Free and relaxed

Each student is free to contribute ideas at any time and develop other ideas for themselves.

- Focus on the quantity of ideas (not Quality)

The aim of the activity is to generate as many ideas as possible. At the initial stage of the activity, it is very important to explore as many ideas as possible without paying attention to the quality of the ideas presented by students. Teachers should set a target, for example, one hundred ideas in 20 minutes.

- Every idea should be recorded

Every idea must be written down, even if it is not a good idea or similar to an idea that has been presented previously, as long as it is expressed in a different way.

- Incubate before evaluating

Students should be given the opportunity to stop or rest (a few minutes or maybe a night) after the idea generation stage

Researcher can draw the conclusion that the implementation of the brainstorming learning model applied at Islamic Elementary School Walisongo Sumberrejo Pasuruan is almost in accordance with brainstorming theory which explains that in this model teachers must really prepare materials to implement this method as support for improving the quality of learning in the classroom.

Assessment of the Brainstorming Learning Model

It can be said that the final stage is the evaluation stage, in this stage, you have the authority to choose what kind of assessment will be used to measure the results of the work/assignments that students have completed. Apart from assessment, in the evaluation stage, conclusions can be drawn about the impact of the Brainstorming method on educators, parents of students, and also the students themselves.

Learning assessment at Islamic Elementary School Walisongo Sumberrejo Pasuruan uses the Brainstorming Method learning model which includes three aspects, namely :

- Knowledge assessment (cognitive) is assessed from the results of exams, tests, and assignments.
